



Bee Origami

Create your own crafty bee to keep at home!



This guide shows how to make origami bees so you can have your own cute critters at home!

What you'll need

- Paper
- Scissors
- Colouring pens or pencils

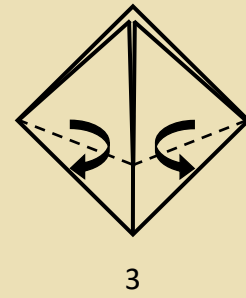
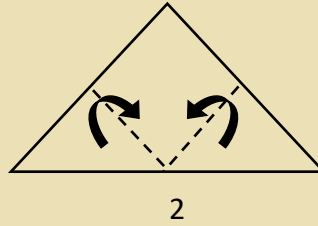
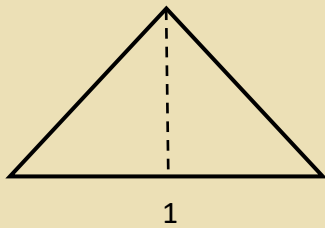


Many more bees!

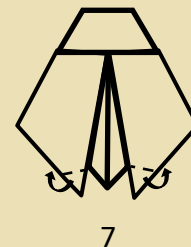
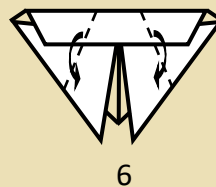
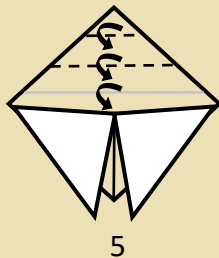
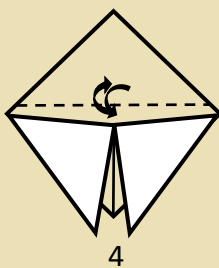
There are lots of different types of bee, including bumble bees, honeybees, and solitary mining bees. All have different colours and markings. Keep a look out next time you are outside.

What to do/instructions:

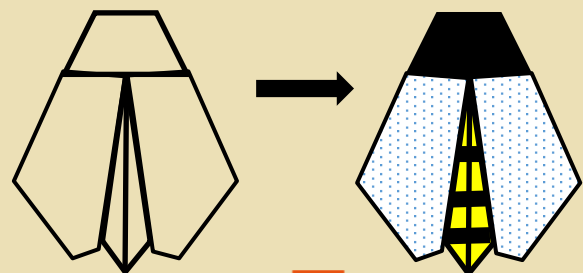
1. Start with a sheet of paper that is cut into an isosceles triangle. Fold in half and unfold out flat again.



2. Fold up the two bottom corners, do not fold over the crease you made in step 1. The two corners will meet at the top of the triangle.
3. Fold the tip of the two corners now at the top back down. However, fold them at a slight diagonal angle so they are away from the centre—like the wings of a bee.
4. Fold down the top of the triangle; not exactly in half, but to just above halfway. As shown in figure 4. Then unfold, this crease will be your guideline for the next step.
5. Fold down the top section of the triangle into thirds meeting up with crease from the fold you made in step 4.
6. Fold back the left & right sides so the fold underneath, up to the dotted line shown in figure 6.
7. Fold the tips of the wings a little so they are no longer pointed.



8. You can now colour or decorate your bee any way you like.
