



Bird Spotter Sheet

Use this bird spotter sheet to identify and learn some common bird species in your garden or local park.



There are many different birds in our parks and gardens, each with its own unique colouring and distinct call. Find somewhere to sit down and see which ones you can spot!

What you'll need

- Pen or pencil
- Bird ID sheet (below)
- Binoculars (optional)
- Clipboard (optional but they help to write and draw with)

What to do/instructions:

1. Print off this bird ID sheet or use it on your phone
2. Go on a woodland walk, to your local park or just in your garden
3. Tick off / make a note of any birds that you spot in your garden or on a walk
4. If you see a bird that's not on this list, in the empty squares below (or just on a blank sheet of paper) you could try and draw the bird's shape and pattern and when you get home try and figure out what it could be!

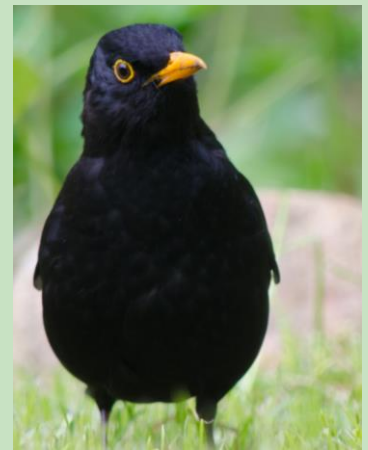

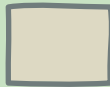
