



Create some mischief in your garden with these Boggarts



Boggarts are mischievous creatures who live in forests. Just like City of Trees, they help to protect our woodlands. Create your very own boggart for your garden or local green space.

What you'll need

- Clay (if your Boggart is going outdoors use natural and non-toxic clay)
- Natural material e.g. leaves, twigs, seeds, moss
- Arts and craft materials e.g. feathers, buttons, pipe cleaners etc.

What to do/instructions:

To make this activity even more fun go on a woodland walk first to collect natural craft materials such as feathers, leaves, sticks, moss and flowers to help make your boggart!

1. Mould a handful of clay into any shape. Circles or ovals make great face shapes.
2. Get your craft materials and make a face with whatever you have/find. Feathers make great boggart hair or use sticks to create a mouth.
3. Once you have created your boggart, place them in your garden, green space or street tree and let them create some mischief!
