



Butterfly Feeder

Watch your garden come to life with your very own butterfly feeder



During the summer, create your very own butterfly feeder to attract lots of butterflies and moths to your garden

What you'll need

- Paper plates
- String or wool
- Sharp pencil
- Colouring pencils or felt pens
- Leftover mushy fruit like bananas or apples (chopped)

What to do/instructions:

1. With a sharp pencil, make four holes around your paper plate (be careful with this and ask an adult to help!)
2. Decorate your paper plate with lots of bright colours. Butterflies are attracted to the bright colours so the more you use the better!
3. After decorating your plate, thread some string or wool through the holes you created and tie them together at the top
4. Why not try and thread some colourful beads on the string to give your feeder an extra splash of colour?
5. Pop the fruit onto the plate for the butterflies and day flying moths to eat
6. Hang from a tree or bush where you can see the butterflies come to feed
