



# Butterfly Mask

This is a great activity to do on a rainy day – get creative and bring the outdoors inside!



Transform yourself into a beautiful butterfly with this step by step guide to making a mask. You can base your design off a butterfly that you have seen or use your imagination and create a new pattern.

## What you'll need

- Butterfly mask template
  - Card
  - Scissors
  - Glue
  - Coloured pens or pencils
  - String
  - Optional: Other craft materials
- such as glitter, coloured paper, feathers.

## What to do/instructions:

1. Download the butterfly mask template and print it out. If you don't have a printer you can just draw it straight on card
2. Using your glue, stick this onto a piece of card and cut around the shape. Ensure that you also cut the eyeholes out
3. Decorate the mask as you wish – get creative with it!
4. Why not look up different species of butterflies and draw inspiration from their colours and patterns?
5. If you can get outside, you could also collect natural materials to add to your design.
6. Cut two holes at the outside edge of the mask. Thread your string through and secure so that you can tie the mask to your head.
7. You are a beautiful butterfly!
