

Colour Palette



This activity is a great one to do as you go on a walk



Nature is full of wonderful, vivid colours. How many different colours can you find on your walk? Try this at different times of year and see how your colour palettes change! Can you arrange your natural materials so that they create a picture?

What you'll need

- Medium thick card
- Double-sided sticky tape

What to do/instructions:

1. Using your card and double-sided tape, make a small sticky collecting palette per person. If you don't have these materials you can always just collect your items and pop them in a bag and arrange when you get home.
2. When you are outdoors, collect as many colours as possible on your colour palette. Look under, inside and behind objects. This can be things like orange leaves, green grass, coloured flowers and even brown bark! Feathers can be a great find to add colour and interest!
3. Try to only collect a small amount per area as to not upset the balance of things.
4. When you get home have a look at what you found and the kinds of colours found in nature.
