

Flower Crowns



Flower crowns are a simple activity that get everyone outdoors and being creative!



In summer decorate with beautiful blooms, come winter you can use ivy, grasses, feathers or lovely leaves for your natural crown.

What you'll need

- Card in a colour of your choice
- Double sided tape
- Scissors
- Stapler
- Flowers, leaves or feathers collected from your garden or outside space

What to do/instructions:

1. Go outdoors and gather any natural materials that you would like to use to decorate your crowns. To avoid too much damage, try to use things that have already fallen to the ground where possible.
2. Cut your card into strips that are around 8cm wide. Ensuring that it is long enough to wrap around your head. If you have A4 card, you can staple two strips together to make one long strip.
3. Place double sided tape along the strip of card to create a sticky surface.
4. Now you are ready to go! Arrange all your collected materials on the card to create a beautiful crown.
5. Once you have finished, staple the two ends of the strip together so that it sits well on your head.
