- Binoculars (optional)

What to do/instructions:

1. Go outside and explore your local park or woodland
2. Tick the box next to the tree when you see it (binoculars can help see, up close and high up leaves).
3. Can't see your tree? Draw or take a picture of the leaves to identify them at home
