

## Wildflower Seed Bombs



Create a wildflower meadow in your own garden with these super easy to make seed bombs



Creating a wildflower meadow has never been easier. These seed bombs can be thrown in gardens to make your garden insect friendly and colourful! They make a great gift too

### What you'll need

- Flour
- Compost
- Mixing bowl
- Water
- Native wildflower seed mix
- Paper cup or jam jar lid (to hold the seed bomb)

## What to do/instructions:

1. Mix one cup of flour and three cups of compost to your mixing bowl.
2. Carefully mix your wildflower seeds into the flour/compost mixture
3. Slowly add water to the mixture until it becomes sticky
4. Take a handful of your mixture and roll into balls with your hands, about the same size as a golf ball
5. Pop them in a paper cup or in jam jar lid
6. Let your seed balls dry out overnight
7. The next day throw your wildflower seed bombs into your garden and wait for them to grow or give them away as a gift!
