

# Woodland Orchestra



Create your own sound of the forest with these musical instruments using natural materials



We can all make noise and with a bit of luck music! With these three instruments you can start building your own orchestra, while at the same time as enjoying the wonders of the woodland while you collect

# What you'll need

## Jingle-sticks

- Find a 'Y' shaped stick
- Collected leaves
- Wooden buttons & beads
- Wool or twine

## **Maracas**

- Seed casings, acorns, small twigs, pebbles, wooden beads.
- Cups
- Tape & glue
- Leaves and other

## **Rattle Drum**

- A strong stick
- 2 young conkers
- Cardboard
- Wool or twine
- Glue/tape & scissors
- Drill (adults only)


# What to do/instructions:

## Jingle-sticks

- Find a sturdy stick that is in the shape of the capital letter 'Y'. No longer then the length of your hand to your elbow.
- Tie the wool/twine around the top of one of the 'Y' arms, making sure it is in a tight and strong knot.
- 3. Thread the wool through the button holes and the beads.
- Using the sharpened pencil make holes in the middle of the leaves and thread them through as well.
- 5. Tie to the loose end of the wool to the second 'Y' arm.
- 6. Now shake and dance to the sound!

#### **Maracas**

- Place the seed casings, acorns, smalls twigs and pebbles into one of the cups. The more you add the louder the noise.
- 2. Place the second cup upside down over the top of the first cup, then tape them together.
- Decorate the cups by gluing or taping all the leaves and natural items to the outside of the cups.
- 4. Start to shake and make those sounds into music.





## **Rattle Drum**

- 1. Adults only. Drill a small hole through the centre of the conker. Young conkers are easier to drill.
- 2. Cut a piece of wool/twine about 15cm long and thread through one of the conkers.

  Tie in big knot in the end so the conker can't slide off the wool.
- 3. Repeat step 2 with the second conker.
- 4. Adult supervision. Using scissors cut out two circles of cardboard about 10am across.
- 5. Place one circle flat on a table and tape the unknotted end of one piece of wool and conker at the 3 o'clock position.
- 6. Tape the second piece of wool with conker to the 9 o'clock position. Make sure that there are equal lengths of string on each side.
- 7. Tape the top of the strong stick to the middle of the circle so that it points out at the 6 o'clock position.
- 8. Place the second circle over the top of the first and tape into place.
- 9. Decorate the card with leaves, or colour in with paints/pens.
- 10. Roll the stick between your palms and MAKE SOME NOISE.
